

## 2023 AEHS Amateur Photography Contest CONTEST RULES

- The AEHS amateur photography contest has one open category.
- All entries must be submitted to AEHS no later than <u>January 31st, 2024.</u>
- Entry fee is \$10.00 CAD per participant.
- Each participant is limited to a maximum of 3 photographs.
- The photographs must have been taken by an active AEHS member and during 2023.
- All images must have a title.
- Each entry must be the work of the participant.
- Photographs taken of other photographs will not be accepted.
- Photos of people must be accompanied by a Publicity and Photo Release form, signed by:
  - o The subject of the photo or if the subject is a minor, by their legal guardian.
- AEHS retains the right to use the entries for promotional purposes during and after the competition. **Photo credits will be given to the original photographer.**
- Prizes for Best of 3 photographs will be awarded.
  - Up to three Honourable Mentions may be awarded at the discretion of the judges.
- Judges panel consists of professional and amateur photographer volunteers.
  - o Judges cannot be part of the contest.
- All prizes must be accepted as awarded.

Digital photos will be accepted for the 2023 amateur photography contest.
