Winners will be announced during the annual AEHS Independence Day Celebration (**Eesti Vabariigi Aastapäev**) on February 24th, 2023, and will be posted on the AEHS website and other AEHS social media sites.

CONTEST RULES

Our third amateur photo contest has one open category.

Each participant can submit a maximum of 3 photos taken during the 2022 calendar year.

- All images must have a title.
- Photographs must have been taken in 2022.
- The photo needs to be taken by an active AEHS member.
- Photographs taken of other photographs will not be accepted.
- Each participant is limited to a maximum of 3 photographs.
- Each entry must be the work of the participant.
- Photos of people must be accompanied by a Publicity and Photo Release form, signed by:
 - *The subject of the photo or if the subject is a minor, by their legal guardian.*
 - *A copy of the Publicity & Photo Release form will be emailed to you with the contest entry form.*
- AEHS retains the right to use the entries for promotional purposes during and after the competition.
- Prizes for Best of 3 photographs will be awarded.
 - *Up to two Honourable Mentions may be awarded at the discretion of the judges.*
- Judges panel consists of professional and amateur photographer volunteers.
 - *Judges cannot be part of the contest.*
- All prizes must be accepted as awarded.

Digital photos will be accepted for the 2022 photo contest.
