

2025 AEHS AMATEUR PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST CONTEST RULES

- The photographs must have been taken by an active AEHS member and during 2025.
- The AEHS amateur photography contest has one open category.
- Entry fee is \$10.00 CAD per participant.
- Each participant is limited to a maximum of 3 photographs, Early Bird entries max 4.
- Each entry must be the work of the participant.
- Photographs taken of other photographs will not be accepted.
- All images must have a title.
- All entries must be submitted to AEHS no later than **January 15th, 2026.**
- *Early bird entry* receives a bonus submission and will be awarded an extra photo entry. Forms need to be submitted, and entry fee paid before **September 30**th, **2025** and up to 4 photographs in total with titles must be submitted prior to January 15th, 2026.
- AEHS retains the right to use the entries for promotional purposes during and after the competition. **Photo credits will be given to the original photographer.**
- Prizes for Best of 3 photographs will be awarded.
 - Runner-up prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Photo Committee members.
- **Public Favourite** category prize will be awarded
- Judges panel consists of professional and amateur photographer volunteers.
 - Judges cannot be part of the contest.
- All prizes must be accepted as awarded.

Digital photos will be accepted for the 2025 amateur photography contest.
